



Jungale Mahal was a district formed by British covering the area under some independent chiefdoms lying between Birbhum, Bankura, Midnapore and the hilly country side of Chota Nagpur . But, the area of Bankura, Purulia, Paschim Medinipur and Jhargram districts of West Bengal is still colloquially referred to as 'Jungle Mahal'
